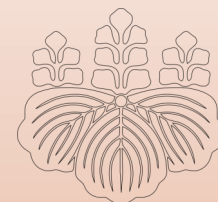
Place: MIT Bartos Theater, 20 Ames Street (Building E15), Atrium Level
